Sevenoaks Suns dish out a 99 surprise to start 2018

The WBBL Championship returned with a bang at the start of January as ten teams took to the court over three days of captivating action. And Sevenoaks Suns continued where they left off from 2017 as they kept their unbeaten start to the season to move to 10-0 in the Championship.

Len Busch's side produced a clinical display in front of the BBC Sport cameras as they eased past Cardiff Met Archers at the Surrey Sports Park.

The Suns came out on fire, making their first nine shots from inside the arc and racked up 52 points in a dominant first half. There was no let up in the second half as Sevenoaks put up the highest points total this season, finally beating their opponents 99 points to 57. The Suns dominated the boards and shot above 60% from 2-point range in a clinical offensive display. Ta'Yani Clark made a strong start to the match and finished with a game-high 21 points with Judit Fritz adding 17 against her former side, while captain Cat Carr also had 17 points to go with another eight assists.

You have to go way back to last April to find the last time the Suns lost a league match. The unbeaten run they have managed to achieve is testament to the work Head Coach Busch is putting in at the club.

Prior to the match, Busch said on the BBC: "2017 was good, we had one little slip up against Nottingham [Wildcats] in the cup. We fully respect Cardiff, they have a couple of players who can cause a lot of damage. We are taking it very seriously and we know we have to play well to get the win. We need to stay focussed and put four quarters together".

Sevenoaks Town start 2018 with nervy draw at Tunbridge Wells but stay top of the table on goal difference

Three league wins in December have kept Sevenoaks Town FC top of the Southern Counties East Football League despite a nervy draw away at Tunbridge Wells in their first match of the year.

Croydon, by comparison, who were in contention for top spot, only took one point from a possible nine over the festive period which has now dropped them to sixth in the table and out of the race for the title.

Sevenoaks' encounter with local rivals Tunbridge Wells did not start well with Brett Ince being sent off after six minutes of the match starting.

However, Sevenoaks held their nerve and the remaining 10-men continued to show

their opponents why they are top of the league.

In recent transfer news, Sevenoaks have signed Lee Carey from Tonbridge Angels. Carey started his career with Brighton & Hove Albion and featured on loan with the Angels as a teenager. He then made a permanent move to Hastings United before returning to the Angels in May 2014.

Manager Micky Collins said on Twitter: "I'm pleased to announce the signing of Lee Carey to Sevenoaks Town FC, a great addition to our squad, can't wait to get working with him".

With Carey's wealth of experience we believe there is only one way this season is going to end.

All football leagues got back underway at the weekend with Kent County Premier League side Otford United beating Bexley by five goals to nil at the Eric Dille Pavilion on Otford Recreation Ground. Four goals from Luke Blackaby and one from Sam Truman secured all three points to leave them in ninth position in the table.

Halstead United and Chipstead, who are currently playing in the Division One West also both won 5-0 on Saturday.

Halstead fought off mild competition away from home at bottom of the league Orpington whilst Chipstead faced stiffer opposition in Halls AFC at Princes Park in Dartford.

Ide Hill's start to 2018 got off to a negative start after going down 2-1 away at Club Langley in Beckenham. Rob Piper coming off the bench to score for Ide Hill.

Kemsing United Reserves saw off Rusthall Club to win 2-1 in Division Two, whilst Green Street Green Rovers beat Borough Green 3-2 away and Sevenoaks Weald held on to beat Tonbridge Invicta Reserves 2-1 at home.

Division Three saw only one match being played as AFC Orpington went down 3-1 at home to Hawkenbury.

There were just the two matches in the bottom division, but they weren't shy of a goal or two. Horsmonden triumphed 5-0 over Paddock Wood whilst West Farleigh Reserves enjoyed the visit of Wilderpark Reserves, finally beating them 8-2.

In the Sevenoaks Charity Junior Cup Nomads 3rd saw off a fantastic challenge from Tatsfield Rovers after going to extra time, the match finished 4-2.

The Smiths League Cups, sponsored by Sevenoaks Sports, were back in the fold on Saturday as St Lawrence beat Blackham & Ashhurst 3-0 in the Senior section whilst Kemsing United dispatched Leigh in a close encounter, finally coming out 4-3 winners to progress to the semi-finals of the premier section and a date with Halls AFC Reserves.

Hockey Club ladies looking to better men indoors

Sevenoaks Ladies finished undefeated and in 2nd place at the half-way stage of the Jaffa Super 6s Division 1 indoor hockey tournament.

Newly promoted into Division 1 this season, Sevenoaks got off to a good start in both their opening matches against Brooklands Poynton and Chelmsford to take the lead at half time. However, in both matches they weren't able to maintain this lead as both matches ended in a draw 4-4 and 3-3 respectively.

Disappointed with only two points from the first two games, Sevenoaks went into game number three against Harleston Magpies knowing it was must-win. After an end-to-end first half finished 0-0 it was Sevenoaks who capitalised in the second half with 16-year-old Renée Ojikutu scoring on debut and Kate Reynolds following up with a neat reverse stick finish on the baseline to secure the 2-0 win.

The last game of the weekend against Beeston was a thriller. Both sides played at a fast pace and aimed to implement their attacking style of play. Beeston found the back of the net in just the first minute but Sevenoaks replied instantly with the next play of the game as captain Susie Rowe fired a long ball to

Kate Reynolds on the post who deflected it into the goal to level the match. Minutes later Susie Rowe scored a goal of her own from a Penalty Corner to put Sevenoaks into the lead and then Sami Danckert found the net after a fine piece of team play to send Sevenoaks 3-1 up into half time. Beeston upped the tempo but Sevenoaks' composure, alongside goalkeeper Dulcie Davies' outstanding saves saw Sevenoaks the eventual 4-2 winners.

At this half-way stage of the tournament Sevenoaks sit in 2nd place and will be looking for a similar performance over the weekend of 13/14 January when they will face top of the table Buckingham, as well as tough games against University of Birmingham, Surbiton and also St Albans.

Different story for Mens XI

Sevenoaks Mens were relegated from the indoor Premier League after a very disappointing second weekend in the Jaffa Super 6s. After only gaining 4 points from a possible 12 in the opening weekend, Oaks were looking to gain at least 9 points from 12 this weekend to stand a chance of finals day qualification, a feat they have achieved in each of the last 3 seasons. However, it was not

to be and they could only manage one win, one draw and two defeats, and their tally of eight points overall saw them finish in the bottom two and they will be playing in Division One next season.

In the opening game of the weekend against Brooklands, Oaks got off to a slow start conceding two early goals and trailed 2-0 at half time. Three quick goals put the Oaks 3-2 up 10 minutes to play. Brooklands levelled up the scores at 3-3 but a last minute goal by Jack Turner saw Oaks snatch the 4-3 win.

Oaks made a strong start against Reading in their second match with Harry Jawanda giving them a 1-0 lead. However, two goals from Reading made it 2-1 before another from the Oaks meant the sides were locked at 2-2 at the interval. In a tight second half Oaks saw the Reading keeper make a number of saves and two quick goals gave Reading a 4-2 lead. Despite piling on the pressure, they couldn't breakthrough until the last play of the game when Jawanda got his second of the game to make it 4-3.

The second day saw Sevenoaks face eventual league winners Wimbledon, and a sluggish start saw Oaks trail 3-0 at half time. Midway through the second half

Wimbledon added a fourth killing any hope of an Oaks comeback. In spite of this Oaks fought until the end and did pull two goals back through Andy Whalley and Chris Barker to make it 4-2 but a last minute Wimbledon goal made the final score 5-2.

Next up Bath, and Oaks needing three points to guarantee Premier League status. Bath took the lead and it remained 1-0 until the break and then extended their lead to 2-0 before David Smith pulled a goal back, before a quick-fire double from Duncan Parnis and Torry put Oaks 3-2. Bath got an immediate equaliser to make it 3-3. Oaks knowing that a point would leave safety out of their hands pushed forwards and Smith scored what looked to be the winner with three minutes remaining, but Bath somehow found a last gasp equaliser to level things up at 4-4 with no time remaining. This meant that Oaks would have to rely on other results

Brooklands managed a draw and a win to draw level with Oaks on 8 points but a better goal difference saw Sevenoaks relegated. This will be a huge blow to Oaks who were looking for a positive indoor campaign to send them back into the outdoor season with some much-needed confidence.
