# 'Complacent' Sevenoaks Town throw lead away

A superb second-half fight back secured Canterbury City a highly deserved share of the points as they battled back from two down at the Bourne Stadium.

A game of two halves saw Sevenoaks go in at the break two goals to the good, which should have been three or four at least, but a rejuvenated Canterbury came back out and pushed them all the way striking back twice to deny the league leaders all three points.

The opening minutes of the match were even but Sevenoaks scored out of nowhere and were then soon getting into their stride and showing some of the form that has taken them to the top of the league. On 11-minutes, Rory Hill received the ball in midfield and he lashed the ball home from 35-yards past a stunned Jack Delo in the Canterbury goal.

It was Sevenoaks in the ascendancy, with their opponents very much second best and in the 30th minute Jason Thompson thumped the ball home from close range with a determined and unchallenged header for a two-nil lead taking them into halftime.

Seemingly rejuvenated though, the visitors then took the game to Sevenoaks and began to cause them problems which the hosts struggled to respond to. Then on 50 minutes,

Canterbury were handed a way back into the game when a player was dragged to the floor in the box for a penalty. Dave Pilcher stepped up and slotted it home, sending the keeper the wrong way for 2-1.

Sevenoaks tried to respond, however it was never enough, and the visitors were now pumped up. A slick, rapid passing move down the hosts left side saw the ball pinged across and Jamie Maxted pounced to ram it home for 2-2 from close range - nothing less than they deserved. All square at the end as Sevenoaks' half-time complacency was deservedly punished by their opponent's resurgent and determined spirit.

Sevenoaks remain at the top of the premier table thanks to second placed Beckenham Town's match away at Rochester City being postponed. They still hold a one-point lead with two games in hand, however there is much more needed from the whole team if they are to go on and win the title this season. # Suns triumph despite several missed opportunities

It was the reigning WBBL champions against the unbeaten leaders on Sunday afternoon and Sevenoaks Suns showed their status as potential champions elect after beating Nottingham Wildcats 69-65 to stay perfect off the back of 18 points from Judit Fritz.

The Sevenoaks Suns made it 11-0 for the season despite a series of missed opportunities and a number of uneccessary fouls at the Sennocke Centre in Sevenoaks.

The home side trailed 63-69 inside the final quarter before putting together a pivotal 13-0 run in a strong finish to secure the win.

Judit Fritz top scored with 18 points, while Cat Carr added 16 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists in the win with head coach, Len Busch, delighted with his side's effort.

"I am very proud of how our team closed out the game

against Nottingham," he declared. "Once again, they came from behind late to win a tough game.

"We knew Nottingham were going to be tough - they are a much better team than their record.

"Cat Carr and Ta'Yani Clark give us a lot of composure late in games and in this one, which helped us to play our best basketball of the game on both ends of the floor in the last seven minutes.

"They are real leaders and very important to our success. It's nice that Judit Fritz is starting to score more points for us - she seems a lot more comfortable.

"Now we have two weeks to review the game and figure out how we can get better before our next game."

The Sennocke Centre played host to the Suns once again after a home fixture was played away at the Surrey Sports Park last week.
