Premier life is proving a tough task

Sevenoaks Hockey Club men's first XI succumbed to a 3-1 defeat away to league leaders Beeston on Sunday, in a game they will feel they should have been able to get more out of. Their hosts were missing five star players due to international duty, so there couldn't have been a better time to face the Nottingham club.

The sides played out a fairly even opening to the game, with both sides enjoying possession, but it was Oaks who should have taken the lead when a good attack from the right hand side ended with the ball falling to Tom Chandler in the D, and his shot across goal rebounded off the inside of the post and away to safety.

Beeston were threatening at the other end and saw a deflected goal chalked off as the ball had not travelled five yards before being played into the D. Shortly after, Beeston were awarded a penalty corner and the initial effort was broken down but a second corner was awarded and this time the flicker found the bottom left corner to make it 1-0. That was how the score remained until the half time break.

After the interval, Beeston doubled their lead after five minutes when another penalty corner was awarded. This time the flick went to the right hand side and despite a valiant effort from the defender on the post, the ball crept over the line to make it 2-0.

Oaks kept working hard but found outcomes hard to come by and they struggled to create opportunities to work the Beeston keeper.

Some good saves by debutant Henry Emmett in the Oaks goal prevented Beeston from extending their lead further, whilst a couple of soft green cards for the Barker twins derailed any momentum Oaks were building up, and with just over 10 minutes remaining, a scrappy goal from a rebound saw the home side extend their lead to 3-0.

A yellow card for Tom Moore with ten minutes left on the clock meant that any chance of a comeback was hampered, but Oaks battled to the end and finally won a penalty corner of their own with a minute remaining. A slick move saw Ali Taylor convert to make the final score 3-1.

With Canterbury losing 6-0 away to Brooklands, the situation remains the same at the foot of the table with Canterbury occupying the automatic relegation spot on 4 points, with Oaks

just above them in 9th place on 5 points, in the relegation play-off spot. With three games remaining, and Brooklands pulling further clear, the best Oaks can hope for is to secure 9th spot and take their chances in the playoffs.

Next weekend they face a home double header with Wimbledon visiting Hollybush Lane on Saturday (1.30pm) and Hampstead & Westminster on Sunday (2pm). All support would be greatly appreciated.

Suns make the most of home court advantage

The Sevenoaks Suns held onto top spot in the WBBL Championship as they held off Westfield Health Sheffield Hatters (76-70) in a top three battle on Sunday afternoon at the Sennocke Centre.

The Hatters had won on Friday night but were unable to inflict a second loss on Len Busch's side - who stretch their advantage over Leicester Riders, albeit having played two games more. They now move to an impressive 16-1 record as they ensured they stayed ahead in the title race.

Judit Fritz starred with an all-round display of 19 points, 7 rebounds and 7 assists for the Suns with Chantelle Pressley producing crucial back-to-back scores to put her side ahead in the fourth

Having trailed at the half, Sheffield edged back ahead at the end of the third and led 69-70 with 4:47 left only to be held scoreless as a 7-0 close gave the hosts victory.

The Suns kept their composure at the foul line as they converted 12 of 14 free

Fritz delight

Star player, Judit Fritz said after the game: "We were preparing for a tough game

against a strong Sheffield team who are currently third in the table and we got nothing less than what we expected".

"They came out strong and played very physical basketball. They gave us some difficulties under the basket and we really had to come together as a team to manage to stop them from getting those "easy baskets" declared Fritz.

"We were doing "our thing" on the offensive end - all we needed was to pick up our defence and match Sheffield's physicality. We did just that. It was a tough game from the tip until the very end.

"I feel extremely happy that we could get away with the win. It was thanks to our determination and to always playing together as a team."

Coach Len Busch added: "I was expecting a tough game, Sheffield are a big team with veteran players. We put together a good defence in

the fourth quarter, they [Sheffield] only scored 9 points in the quarter and that was the difference in the game for us".

Sevenoaks now face a break in the league championship and will return to the court at the Sennocke Centre on April 18th at 7.30pm against Durham Palatinates. Then then host Oakland Wolves on April 22nd (3.00pm) before heading to Manchester to play the Mystics in their final game on April 28th (4.00pm).

WBBL Trophy

Although Sevenoaks face a break in league action, they will now prepare for the WBBL Trophy before the end of the season recommences. Their first round tie in this end of season cup is away to the Oakland Wolves, who play in St. Albans, on March 24.
