Sevenoaks plough their way to seven clear

Sevenoaks Town moved seven points clear at the top of the table after a 4-1 home victory against struggling Hollands & Blair. On a day more suited to sledging, the team at Sevenoaks Town, led by Chairman Paul Lansdale, did the club proud as they swept the snow off the 3G pitch to get the game on, with the majority of other fixtures in the league postponed.

Kenny Pogue got the hosts off to an excellent start to the game with a goal in the 8th minute, yet Blair were straight back in it through Kushal Campbell just a minute later.

With just 12 minutes gone Pogue had got his second to put Sevenoaks back in front and that lead was extended on the half hour mark when Brett Ince found the net.

The home side wrapped things up in the second half through Harrison Carnegie on the hour and can now look down at the pack seven points below them.

Sevenoaks host fifth placed Croydon on Tuesday evening at 7.45pm at The Bourne Stadium before travelling to fourth placed Whitstable Town next Saturday. They then play Beckenham Town on Tuesday week. These seven days could see Sevenoaks become champions elect? The way they are playing at present suggests no one is going to stop them on their quest for league glory.

Sevenoaks Powerchair team go top of the league

Sevenoaks PFC returned to Nottingham Trent University at the weekend to play in the next round of league matches, and left feeling proud of themselves as they won three out of three matches to go top of the Muscular Dystrophy UK Championship.

They started the weekend early on Saturday morning with a tough 1-0 win against Muscle Warriors PFC, Dan Stevens getting the only goal of the game.

Sevenoaks then faced Telford PFC just after lunch, however Sevenoaks were not stopping for anyone as they continued their fine play coming away with the biggest win the league has seen all season, 11-0. Kyle Alexander (3), Harry Bestwick (2), Myles Miller (4), Shaye Reid-Watson (2) were the goalscorers.

Sevenoaks then finished off their Saturday schedule against Electric Eels from Hull, who are sitting mid-table.

Alexander was again on the score sheet but it was Miller who took another three goals to give him a tally of seven for the weekend, an average of 2.33 goals per game.

Unfortunately due to the weather conditions only half of the scheduled matches were competed as all teams were sent home.

It is not yet sure when these fixtures will be replayed but the next, and final, round will be held again at Nottingham Trent University on the weekend of May 12/13.

Although Sevenoaks have topped the table this weekend, Leeds PFC have a game in hand and only trail by one point.

Friday night football kicks off at Greatness Park

Friday saw the first of nine cup finals to be played at The Bourne Stadium in Greatness Park this season, with Southborough Reserves facing The Bull Horton Kirby in the first Smiths Cup final to be played on a 3G pitch.

The Smiths League Cup, which is this year sponsored by Sevenoaks Sports magazine, is contested in each of the Sevenoaks & District Football League's divisions, this match representing Division Three.

Southborough controlled most parts of the game however they let The Bull HK back into the match in the dying seconds to finish 4-4. Extra time ensued but Southborough managed to score another four goals to make sure they were going

home with the season's first piece of silverware.

Saturday only saw four matches played and completed. The highlight was the Sevenoaks Charity Senior Cup semi-final between Ide Hill and Ightham held on the 3G pitch at Wrotham School.

But unlike The Bourne Stadium (right) there was little to no brushing of the pitch except for the lines. This made it a very tricky prospect for both teams and the referee.

In a close first half, the teams went in level at the break, 1-1. However in the second half, Ightham came out the stronger team and quickly scored two goals, and despite a late consolation from Ide Hill, they held on to win 3-2. Ightham will now face Malgo FC in this

winning the match 5-2. Division Three saw a tight game between local rivals Pembury and Hawkenbury, with the match finishing 2-2 which keeps Hawkenbury at the top of the table at least until Southborough Reserves play their two games in hand.
