Sevenoaks pull together for play-off challenge

Sevenoaks Hockey Club mens first XI escaped automatic relegation on the last day of a testing season in the Mens Hockey League Premier Division at the weekend.

Hampstead & Westminster were seemingly placed in charge of the relegation battle having to play both Sevenoaks and Canterbury on the final weekend.

On Saturday they visited Hollybush Lane and although Sevenoaks gave a good account of themselves in the first half, they mauled the home side in the latter stages of the match, finally winning 10-2.

Some bizarre tactics however, meant that both teams finished the match without their goalkeepers on the pitch and Sevenoaks sadly with only 10-men.

H&W then travelled to Canterbury on Sunday, and despite the home side taking a 3-1 lead into the half (there were a few nervous moments at Sevenoaks Sports HQ), they succumbed to the power of H&W and went down 5-3.

These results now confirm that Canterbury are now automatically relegated and Sevenoaks will contest their position in the top flight with the winners of the three Conferences.

The Play-offs

Sevenoaks, being the ninth-placed team from the Premier Division, will now battle it out in a round robin tournament for two spaces in the top tier starting on April 22 at the Nottingham Hockey Centre. It has been confirmed that they will face Oxted, the University of Exeter and the University of Nottingham.

Local rivals Oxted triumphed in the Mens Hockey League Conference East with a 72% win ratio, beating second placed Southgate by six points. The play-offs will provide Sevenoaks with the opportunity to rectify what has been a disappointing first season in the Premier Division.

Suns shine brightly in south-east Trophy match up

Sevenoaks Suns wasted very little time in stamping their authority all over their WBBL Trophy clash at Oaklands Wolves, the final score Wolves 42 Suns 62.

The holders made a statement of intent right from the tip-off as they cruised to victory in Hertfordshire in a real team effort.

The Suns made the most of a stone-cold start by the home side to use their swarming defence to build a 4-21

advantage after 10 minutes. It was plain sailing for Sevenoaks after this.

And while Sevenoaks had one of their poorest games of the season in terms of shooting, they were still head and shoulders above an eye-watering 15 of 61 from Wolves.

Julia Koppl was the game hero posting a smart 17 points from 60% shooting and added 8 boards, while Cat Carr had an all-action 16 points, 6 rebounds and 5 assists.

Leading scorers for Sevenoaks were: Koppl (17), Carr (16) and Ta'Yani Clark (11).

Sevenoaks will now play BA London Lions in the next round this Sunday. The Lions currently sit bottom of the Championship table without a league win all season. The draw also sees Nottingham Wildcats travel to on-form Leicester Riders. The final is due to take place on Saturday 14th April at the Cheshire Oaks Arena in Ellesmere Port.

Sevenoaks Town slip up in Whitstable

Frankie Sawyer's tenth goal in seven games proved too little too late for Sevenoaks Town at Whitstable Town on Saturday.

Two Ricky Freeman goals in the space of as many minutes put the home side in the driving seat by half-time.

The in-form Sawyer pounced four minutes from time, stabbing home substitute Byron Walker's knockdown to set up a frantic finale.

Ben Wilson and fellow sub Josh Froggatt both had stoppage-time efforts saved by Whitstable goalkeeper Dan Eason, but Town had left themselves too much to do.

So, with ten games left, Sevenoaks will need to find another gear as they head into

the busy Easter schedule. And with seven of those remaining matches away from the comfort of their 3G pitch, manager Micky Collins will be wanting his men to travel well.

On Tuesday night they are away to third placed Beckenham Town FC before hosting AFC Croydon at The Bourne Stadium on Easter Saturday. They complete the weeks fixtures with another away match at second placed Crowborough Athletic.
