Relentless Suns return to WBBL Trophy Final

WBBL Betty Codona Trophy holders Sevenoaks Suns are now just 40 minutes away from successfully defending their prized silverware after easing past Caledonia Pride in the Semi-Finals.

They will go head-to-head with Leicester Riders in a repeat of their title showdown 12 months ago.

Suns had too many weapons for Pride and shut their opponents down impressively to seal victory and deny the Scottish side a second major final appearance of the campaign.

Even though Pride posted the first couple of buckets in the contest, it was a false dawn and it seemed to kick start Suns into life. They held Pride to just 4 more points in 8 minutes to take the first quarter 19-9 and never had cause to look back.

Cat Carr led by example as usual with a captain's contribution of 21 points along with 8 assists, while Ta'Yani Clark posted 14 points, 12 rebounds and 7 assists in an impressive all-round display.

Pride shot a total 13 of 52 which will not win you many games of basketball, but that was all credit to the relentless Suns defence.

The leading scorers for Sevenoaks against Pride were Carr 21, Clark (14), Julia Koppl (12 and Judit Fritz (12).

"The team and the whole club are all looking forward to us being in the final," said Suns' guard, Renee Busch. "We were focused coming into the game against Caledonia, especially after how close the game was the last time we played them away.

"We were proud of our defence. I think we showed improvement in playing together and we did what we had to do to win.

Sevenoaks Town are on the march to the title

Sevenoaks Town FC have set up a mouthwatering final seven games of the season after dispatching Beckenham Town 4-2 on Saturday afternoon at The Bourne Stadium.

The leaders of the Southern Counties East Premier Division held off numerous challenges from the visitors to stay 10 points clear of Crowborough Athletic, who scored a late goal in their home game versus Erith Town to give them all three points.

Brett Ince opened the scoring on seven minutes to give Town a well deserved lead in this exciting tie, however Marvin Alebiosu got one back for the visitors shortly afterwards.

In remained 1-1 until just after the half hour mark, when Jack Miles sneaked in at the back post to head home through the smallest of gaps after a fantastic free kick was taken from the left.

They went in 2-1 at the break which gave Sevenoaks manager, Micky Collins, enough to be pleased about. Although this tie was far from

over, especially given the nature of the reverse fixture just 11 days before, when Sevenoaks needed a late winner to make it 3-2 after leading the game 2-0.

Town came out in the second half with their ears pricked and it wasn't long before Chris Edwards got Sevenoaks' third on 51 minutes.

The home side looked to be cruising but Beckenham were not finished as Jamie Humphris got their second in the 76th minute. A defensive nightmare as Beckenham went the entire length of the pitch without one challenge. Kenny Pogue restored Sevenoaks' two-goal lead after 81 minutes with a wonderful header to make it 4-2.

Beckenham somewhat soured the match towards the end part of the game however, with two players being sent off by referee, Kirsty Dowle.

She was spot-on with her decision making, which also included Byron Walker and Kenny Pogue picking up warnings as well.
