On a beautifully warm and sunny day, Lizzy Yarnold, the first Briton to retain a Winter Olympic title, stepped on to her very own Victory Bus outside the Council offices in Sevenoaks Town Centre for the second time.

It was a fitting celebration of Sevenoaks' very own golden girl and one that her supporters will surely never forget. Lizzy's open top double-decker bus, which was organised by the District Council (as they had done previously in 2014), took in a pre-planned route through the towns and villages of the district including

Sevenoaks, Bat and Ball, Otford, Shoreham, Eynsford, Farningham, Swanley, Horton Kirby and West Kingsdown on Wednesday 18th April.

St John's Primary School certainly made the first impression of the day on behalf of Sevenoaks Town, as they gathered on the Vine to wish Lizzy good luck as she started her tour around the area.

She gave inspirational speeches about her Olympic achievements as she met pupils from Trinity School, Weald of Kent Grammar School, Knole Academy, Riverhead Infants, Orchards Academy

Horton Kirby, Sutton-at-Hone and West Kingsdown Schools.

Sevenoaks District Council leader Peter Fleming said: "What a fantastic day it's been. Absolutely everywhere we've been people have been out waving flags. People want to cheer Lizzy on and the reaction has been phenomenal from the schools. She wanted to make sure she was inspiring the next generation".

## Sevenoaks stunned in Sheppey shocker

Sevenoaks Town were stunned into defeat at The Bourne Stadium on Saturday losing 2-5 to Sheppey United.

A first half hat-trick from Dan Bradshaw was added to by Remell Davis and a late own goal to give Sheppey an incredible win and keep the title race going into the final week.

Sevenoaks, who scored both their goals via Frankie Sawyer spot kicks, must now regroup and ensure they get over the line as they go into the final three games.

That final week starts with a match on Tuesday evening away to Corinthian before travelling to Erith Town on Saturday afternoon and finally Crowborough Athletic on Monday night.

A victory for Sevenoaks against Corinthian should confirm promotion but the visitors will be happier with the six-point gap it would give them over second placed Whitstable Town.

Whitstable also have three games remaining in what could be a very tight end to championship. They face Rochester United on Wednesday night before travelling to Cray Valley PM and finally Lordswood on Monday evening.

It could be a huge night come Monday should Sevenoaks not win their next two games.

## Oaks in winning start to Premier playoffs

Sevenoaks got off to a winning start in this year's Premier League promotion/relegation playoff tournament, beating local rivals Oxted 3-2 in Nottingham on Sunday.

Having endured a tough debut season in the Premier League, Oaks came into the playoffs having lost considerably more games than they had won this season. Oxted conversely as National Conference East Champions were coming into the game on the crest of a wave of confidence. As such, getting back to winning ways for Oaks was never a foregone conclusion.

After the game, captain Tim Warrington said "We're obviously delighted with the win today. It was a tough game, against a good Oxted side, who pushed us all the way. We've had a very challenging season, being on the wrong end of results most weeks, so to have the mental strength to find a late winner was great to see. I think our experience in the playoffs last year contributed to our result - last year we beat both Bath Buccs and Durham Uni 3-2 and we took confidence from that when we were 1-0 and 2-1 down today, knowing that we had history of finding a way to win last year. Also, a special mention to the travelling Oaks supporters for there never ending support and encouragement - they really helped us over the line today".

In a fairly even opening 15 minutes neither side really troubled the keeper and it was a relatively cagey affair. In the 15th minute a turnover in the Oaks defence, followed by a mix-up in the D, allowed Oxted their first real opportunity and despite Richard Potton making

the initial save the ball was put in on the rebound to give Oxted a 1-0 lead.

Sevenoaks responded well and continued to put Oxted under increasing pressure and just before the half hour mark some excellent build up play by Max Denniff led to Tom Samuel being able to fire a ball into the Oxted D where Tim Warrington was on hand to deflect past the keeper into the back of the net to make the score 1-1.

Moments later it was nearly 2-1 to Oaks as a quickly taken side line by Warrington saw Ali Taylor feed the ball into Tejinder Hanspal in the D and his shot squeezed between the keeper's legs but trickled just wide of the goal.

Having dominated the closing periods of the first half, Oaks were stunned early in the second half when just four minutes in another defensive turnover gave Oxted an opportunity and the forward crashed a powerful shot towards the Oaks goal to give Oxted a 2-1 lead.

Once again, the Oaks response was good, and they created a couple of good chances; first Duncan Parnis saw a one-on-one saved by the Oxted keeper and second

a penalty corner was tipped round the post to keep Oxted ahead.

With just over 15 minutes remaining Mike Barker jinked his way into the D and saw his reverse stick effort saved by the keeper but Michael Shelton pounced on the rebound and fired a reverse stick shot under the keeper and into the back of the net to level the scores at 2-2.

With seven minutes remaining an Oaks attack ended with another save by the Oxted keeper, but the ball squirmed wide in the D and from a very narrow angle Parnis crashed a reverse stick shot that found the back of the net in off the far post to make it 3-2.

Oaks managed to see out the remaining minutes fairly comfortably barring the award of a penalty to Oxted with two minutes remaining, but the defensive unit kept the ball out.

The final whistle blew Oaks and had secured a precious 3-2 victory which sets them up well for the remaining two games of the playoff tournament this weekend in Birmingham when they face Exeter University and Nottingham University.

## Sevenoaks Rugby 1st XV finish league season in style

Sevenoaks Rugby 1st XV closed the book on its 2017/18 season in London 1 South with an outstanding 44-26 win over Chichester in the sunshine on Saturday.

Oaks took it to Chichester from the get go and plundered a converted try within minutes of the kick off, and some time before the full contingent of 100 guests at the Match Day Lunch in memory of fallen Mighty Oaks Peter Hunt and Ian Wood had made its way to the Bradshaw-Pearl Balcony.

Chichester immediately responded; they ghosted through the Oaks defence to dot the ball down under the posts and slot the conversion through the uprights before repeating the same trick moments later. Three tries inside five minutes suggested a try fest was in the offing and so it transpired.

The pick of Oaks' five tries came just before the first half break; the ball was moved left

then right before Josh Pettit combined with Jiggy to level the score. The immaculate boot of Ben Adams, who kicked eight kicks from eight attempts in a fine place-kicking display, gave the Oaks a marginal 17-14 advantage to take into the half-time break.

The game continued to ebb and flow before two telling scores broke the hearts of the exuberant and game travelling Chichester faithful. First the Oaks pack rumbled the ball over the line all the way from just outside the Chichester 22, then Sean Derrick capped another imposing display with an interception try that saw him outpace, sidestep and exhaust the efforts of the covering defence.

Oaks finish the season in ninth position in London 1 South, short of their target though thankfully clear of a drop zone that saw three teams relegated. The squad will now enjoy an end of

season tour to Ghent alongside pals from the 4th's before recharging the batteries for the joys of off season training, which begins on 30 June.

Overall the Club's seniors and juniors have enjoyed an exceptional season with highlights including four Kent Cups for the Acorns, Under 16s and Under 13s Boys; Kent and Regional Cups for the Under 15s Girls, and League Victory for the 4th XV.

"To win our final game in such style says everything about the quality and commitment of the entire squad," said Coach Adam Bowman. "Our performances in a very tough League this season have been solid, and we have held firm to our principles of investing in and nurturing local talent."

"The Juniors' outstanding results bode well for the future and plans for the 2018/19 campaign are well underway."
