### Perfect weekend as Town and Suns take Championships

**S**evenoaks Town Football Club and Sevenoaks Suns both made history on Saturday as they secured their respective league titles for the first time in their clubs history.

On Saturday afternoon Sevenoaks Town travelled up the M25 to play Erith Town in their penultimate fixture, knowing that a win would all but secure the Southern Counties East Football League title.

In a tense battle, Oaks were rewarded with their defensive play, finally winning the match 2-1 thanks to goals from Frankie Sawyer and Kenny Pogue. And whilst second-placed Whitstable Town were unable to get a result on the road at Cray Valley, it meant that Sevenoaks were finally crowned League Champions.

Likewise, Sevenoaks Suns knew that a win on the road at Manchester Mystics on Saturday night would also give them a well deserved league title.

Their team defence proved priceless as they shut down Manchester Mystics 44-57, with standout performances from Ta'Yani Clark who fired 16 smarts and team captain Cat Carr, who only missed out on a triple-double by a solitary assist.

The Leicester Riders, their nearest rivals, were unable to better the Suns record, so coach Len Busch was able to celebrate by lifting the Suns first WBBL Championship.

# The hard work starts now as Sevenoaks Town get ready for life in the Bostik South League

After their league heroics, in which they only lost four games all season, Sevenoaks Town Football Club will now start to plan for life in the Bostik South League and it's something that they've been looking forward to for a very long time.

In February, Sevenoaks Sports magazine reported on the club's dynamic duo of Manager Micky Collins and Chairman Paul Lansdale and the wonderful relationship they have built at the club in the last four years.

This was clearly evident on Saturday afternoon as they embraced each other knowing that their hard work and effort had finally paid off, and that they could start to celebrate Sevenoaks Town being a Step 4 club.

We caught up with them both again at their clubhouse in Greatness Park, where the whole team had gone to celebrate their league heroics together.

Micky Collins was delighted with his sides success saying: "It's been a long hard road and it's fantastic. To get it over the line is incredible.

"I don't think everyone here, including me, realises what we've done for the club. And not just for the club, the town as well. It's not just me though, the whole club have done this, from Paul [Lansdale] the Chairman, right up

through everybody, we've all pulled together and it's taken us four years.

On a more personal note, Collins didn't want it to go down to the last game away at Crowborough on Monday night, he said: "I didn't want to have to go into the last game of the season and have to win. The boys did it today and Cray Valley did us a favour beating Whitstable, it's nice to get it done".

"Now we can look at the promotion and we can look at what's involved for next season.

"I've been here before and I know what it takes, and I know what we need to do to be prepared for next season, there are some very good sides in the league who will be hard to beat."

A particular highlight of next season fixtures will be an away tie versus Guernsey. Although it is hoped this match will not be arranged on Boxing day or New Years Day. Asked about the size of his squad and whether they can cope with the step up to the Bostik South, he commented that the next six weeks will be key as he looks to bring the right people in.

He said: "The last thing we want to do is be sitting here next season thinking we've just come back down. I know that Paul and the board will support me to bring in the right personnel to get the job done".

Lansdale was obviously quite moved by the whole occasion as he looked around at his team; from the clubhouse staff to the players, the manager and his supporting committee members, all of whom have been with him all the way.

He put it simply when he said: "It's great, I'm pleased for the guys and I'm very proud of everything we've achieved together. The hard work really does start now".

## Suns finally get their hands on the WBBL Championship

Sevenoaks Suns continue to go from strength to strength as they consolidated their status as a powerhouse basketball franchise by lifting their first WBBL Suns Championship success on

Saturday night. And how apt that they should do so at the National Basketball Performance Centre in Manchester.

Suns locked out Manchester Mystics 44-57 to

write another chapter of their history, having won the WBBL Trophy and WBBL Play-Offs last season.

The win also made up for losing the recent Betty Codona WBBL Trophy Final to Leicester Riders by edging out their rivals for the league title. The Suns always held the upper hand off the back of their stifling defence which was evident right from the tip-off. Ta'Yani Clark caught the eye with an efficient 16 points from 66% shooting, while Cat Carr was just one assist short of a triple-double after scoring 11 points and harvesting 14 boards.

The Mystics final points tally speaks volumes – as does the fact that Suns had 8

different scorers. The Suns leading scorers were Ta'Yani Clark (16), Chantelle Pressley (13) and Cat Carr (11).

They will be strongly fancied to now make it back to The O2 and the potential prospect of defending their Play-Off silverware next month.

Enthused Head Coach, Len Busch said of the win: "We have deserved this due to hard work, playing together and believing in ourselves.

"The road has been hard and we have faced our obstacles, but that's what makes this group really special. They have earned this win and the Championship. I'm truly delighted for them," he added.

## Premier status secured after last day play off victory

Sevenoaks Hockey Club Men's first XI managed to secure their top flight status after beating the University of Nottingham 2-1 on Sunday.

The club remain in England Hockey's Premier Division after finishing second in the round-robin playoff finals, having beaten Oxted the previous week, and losing a fierce game against the University of Exeter on Saturday.

Tim Warrington, the Sevenoaks Captain said: "It's been a long hard season but this makes it all worthwhile [to stay up]. We knew that only a win on Sunday against Nottingham University would be enough due to our adverse goal difference".

Sevenoaks went into the second weekend of the promotion/relegation playoffs having put themselves in a strong position with a 3-2 victory over local rivals Oxted

last weekend. However things were turned on their head after a lacklustre display against Exeter University on Saturday saw Oaks lose 6-3 (Goals from: David Smith, Duncan Parnis and Mike Shelton). With Oxted beating Nottingham University, it left everyone in the pool on 3 points with one game remaining.

Sevenoaks made a bright start to their final game and after only 10 minutes they took the lead when 16-year-old Louis Tipper skipped past a challenge on the top of the D and lashed a thunderbolt of a shot over the keeper's shoulder into the roof of the net. The lead was not to last long though as Nottingham won a penalty corner four minutes later and it was converted to draw the sides level at 1-1 at the half time break.

It took Oaks just six minutes into the second half to retake

the lead when superb forward pressing from Mike Barber saw him steal the ball off the deepest Nottingham defender, before advancing into the left hand side of the D to rifle a reverse stick shot past the keeper at the near post and into the back of the net to make it 2-1.

Oaks pressed knowing a one goal lead was precarious, and a Nottingham equaliser

would likely send them up instead.

Nottingham were awarded another penalty corner and this time Potton and the defence were beaten but the ball rebounded off the post and was cleared to safety.

Oaks clung on for the remaining minute to win 2-1 and retained their Premier League status for next season.
