Vine and Holmesdale get off to the perfect start

On a warm sunny day Sevenoaks Vine hosted newly promoted Bickley Park for their opening Kent League Premier match of the season. Skipper, Olly Howick, won the toss and in front of a good crowd, significantly augmented by Hockey Club Vets festival players, elected to bat first.

On a slow early season wicket the Vine top order found runs hard to come by and early wickets fell regularly. With the scoreboard at 47 for 4, Miles Richardson joined Max Aitken and they put on a stand of 27 to steady the ship. When Aitken lost his wicket, Richardson was

joined by Cyrus White and they set about building a recovery with a stand of 112.

White started cautiously whilst Richardson began to open up, hitting some glorious boundaries and looked set for a well-deserved century when he "missed a straight one" trying to accelerate the scoring and fell, bowled, for 82. White, growing in confidence, took up the charge, hitting a big 6 straight back over the bowler's head with 52 not out at the close of the innings, his maiden 1st XI half century giving the Vine a creditable 207 for 7.

Bickley Parks' inning closely mirrored

that of the Vine, the top order falling cheaply, with two wickets for the pacey Richardson and one each for Tom Parsons and the debutant Alex Christie.

At 42 for 4, the target set by the Vine was looking vulnerable. In a series of twists and turns

the game was there for the winning by either side as a run out and a quick Yorker by Man of the Match Richardson, his 4th wicket in 10 overs, set up an exciting finish. Some terrific fielding by Max Aitken and Tom Coldman, resulting in two crucial runouts, saw Bickley Park all out in the last over just two runs short.

Reflecting on a well-deserved win for the Vine and a welcome 18 points, Head Coach Rick Parsons said: "I was impressed by the team spirit today, and the application that had seen both the batting recovery and calmness in the field as Bickley closed in on the target".

Sevenoaks Vine travel to Blackheath next Saturday full of confidence and with key players in good form and improving availability, they will be hoping for another strong performance.

Holmesdale won their first match back in Division One after beating Folkestone. Holmesdale lost the toss but were given the bat and recorded 174 all out with Mark Epps top scoring on 40. Folkestone managed just 159 runs in reply.

Sevenoaks Vine 2nd's arrived at Hartley with plenty of new faces amongst the old for a difficult first match.

Put into the field first, Vine opening bowlers Boudville and Procter provided the Hartley batsman with some outstanding balls; however, they played the openers well with Green leading the way making 83, caught by Coleman. Fortunes changed when spinners Reid-Dick and Thompson were introduced, bowling with great accuracy with wickets falling at regular intervals. Thompson picking up 3-30. Procter (2-54) and Robinson (3-13) cleaned up the lower order with Hartley finishing on 235 all out.

The Vine chase didn't start out as hoped, losing Harvey early on, but Thompson and Quinney negated the Hartley openers well until Quinney was caught for 17. This was the beginning of a difficult period for the Vine losing wickets regularly and struggling to negate the Hartley seamers. The Vine finally being bowled out for 69.

They will look to put it behind them quickly, turning their attention to derby day against their local rivals Holmesdale this Saturday.

Sevenoaks Vine 3rd's travelled to Rochester to play Sherwood 2nds in the Kent Regional 2A Central league. Sherwood won the toss and elected to bat, tight bowling from Gavin, Tudor and Martin kept the run rate down to two and a

Harry Houillon and Mike Martin opened and posted 47 for the first wicket, Martin falling to the first lofted drive stalling in the air and caught at mid on, but it was to be Houillon's day batting all the way through for 102* to add to his 2 stumpings and one catch behind as he returned to keeping after breaking his ankle... but there's still room for improvement he did drop one all be it a hard chance. They now look forward to hosting Upchurch CC at Orchard Field this Saturday.

Suns stretch their arms towards another trophy

The WBBL league champions and Play-off top seeds, Sevenoaks Suns, left it late to overcome the lowest seed Cardiff Met Archers in the post-season quarter-finals on Sunday afternoon, eventually prevailing 68-56 at Surrey Sports Park.

It means Suns, who won the Play-offs last season and finished the regular campaign with six straight league wins, hold eight victories in a row over Archers dating back two years.

The teams were close throughout in this match and it wasn't until Renee Busch hit a three-pointer on the third quarter buzzer that Suns managed to break clear. She then added another early in the fourth, with Cat Carr scoring five points in what became an 11-2 run over the break for a decisive 54-45 lead.

In a particularly defensive game where neither team scored well, Suns were strong on the offensive boards to get

second chances. 22 offensive rebounds led to 19 second chance points, with Chantelle Pressley pulling in five of those and ending on 17 personal points.

Busch scored crucial late baskets and changed the momentum of the game, showing great resilience having shot 0-11 up to that point. But Cat Carr led the Suns, with 21 points, six rebounds and three assists.

Scorers for Sevenoaks were Cat Carr (21), Chantelle Pressley (17), Judit Fritz (11) (Suns); Julia Koppl (8) Renee Busch (6) and Ta'Yani Clarke (5).

Sevenoaks will now play Nottingham Wildcats in a bid to reach the Play-Off Finals at the O2 Arena on Sunday 20th May. In the other semi final, Leicester Riders host Sheffield Hatters.

Meanwhile, Chantelle Pressley, a silver medallist with Team England at the recent Commonwealth Games on the Gold Coast, Australia, has been named in the Molten WBBL All-British Team for 2017-18 - as voted for by all of the WBBL clubs. Well done Telley!
