### Ide Hill continue their great start to new season

**Kent County League Division One West  
- Sutton Athletic Reserves 1 Ide Hill 3**

Ide Hill went in to their third game of the season looking to build on an encouraging early season form, to keep pace with the league leaders in what is hoped will be a strong campaign.

Following a blistering end to last season and an unbeaten start to this, a deep squad have the feel of one who could do well over the course of the season. Ide Hill began in a 3-5-2 line-up and the early exchanges were scrappy on a narrow pitch, with both teams struggling for space and looking to hit long balls into the forwards with little initial success.

Quickly, though, Ide Hill began to make inroads, with probing long balls from Philippe Alteirac and Ben Pearson causing problems, and the incisive and powerful link play of Columb Grant and Callum Heath up front creating holes and panic in their opponents back line.

After 15 minutes, Ide Hill were controlling the game and the warning signs were there for Sutton. Pearson charging forward from his right sided centre back slot, exchanged passes with an advanced Driver and laid on the ball for Grant to drag wide from 18 yards. Heath was causing problems all over the backline too, his blend of power, athleticism and tenacity causing regular headaches for the home side, creating his own chances and openings for those around him.

The opening goal came after half an hour, a clever long ball from Pearson releasing Grant in the box down the right who calmly slotted beyond the advancing keeper and into the corner. Ide Hill went into the break fully in control, but having

been in similar positions over the opening weeks, they were wary of undoing their first half dominance once more.

But the Hill would ultimately stitch together their first full, controlled performance of the season, by pulling away convincingly in the second half. George Kensell's energy and running beyond the forwards allowed space for Craig Jackson to run in the box to cross, with the sliding Sutton captain handling and conceding the penalty which Jackson duly converted for 2-0.

The best was yet to come though. A raft of changes on the hour saw Robert Piper enter on the right of a front three. Picking the ball up 30 yards out, he glided in from the wing and smashed an unstoppable long range drive into the top corner for an early goal of the season contender.

Ide Hill could have had more and probably should have, Tom Wright

heading a good chance wide and Jackson missing a gilt edged chance after an excellent back heel by Kensell.

The new back three of Pearson, Charlie James and Alteirac looked dominant throughout. Holder had a controlled and classy game at the base of the midfield and the wingbacks of Driver and Jaymes Randall offered enthusiasm and energy up and down the flanks all game.

Sutton did pull one back via a penalty follow up with 10 minutes left, which the goalkeeper, Mike McKay, initially saved but the visitors held firm to take the three points and lift the team to second in the league at this early stage of the season.

An uncharacteristically positive start to the season for the Hill will hope to gather more momentum next week with Stansfield before an early top of the table clash against Club Langley the following week.



# Cyclo Sportive welcomes young cyclists and a couple of 'Boris' bikes!

450 people gathered to take part in the 21st annual Circuit Of Kent Cyclo Sportive on Sunday, including a seven year old boy and an eight year old girl. The event is a challenge cycle ride which is organised by Sevenoaks Amherst Rotary Club and got underway in near perfect weather conditions.

With a choice of 40kms, 80kms and 130kms riders are given a time based on their age and gender, and can go for a gold, silver or bronze standard time. All riders are given an electronically operated tag to wear and their times are recorded as they pass under the finish banner. However, it is not a race and entrants have the choice of riding as slow or as fast as they wish.

The 40km route which was introduced in 2016, has proven popular with young families and amateur cyclists. It runs from Sevenoaks Prep School through Plaxtol to East Peckham and back past Shipbourne. This shorter route is intended for families accompanying children as long as they are competent to ride on the road, have a helmet and suitable bicycle. The route is challenging and includes the infamous Carter's Hill, so is not really recommended for those under 12 years old.

However, Florence Vella, aged eight, and her father Ben from Dartford plus Derek Bleeker and his son Johannes, seven years old, from Sevenoaks both took on the challenge and completed it whilst having fun with their dads.

Meanwhile, Gary Donald and James Woodford from New Eltham arrived on their specially adapted wheelchair bikes. Each bike has 32 gears and they both cycled the 40km course. Gary and James started The London Wheelchair Triathlon Club earlier this year. It's a club centred

around the Queen Elizabeth Olympic Park in East London and is looking for wheelchair members to take part in distance (endurance) events using a race chair, handcycle or swimming, or any combination for duathlons and triathlons.

Lastly, but by no means least, friends Andrew McMillan and Joseph McLean who live and work in London decided to take a different approach to the Cyclo event.

They hired Boris Bike's for the day at London Bridge, then caught the train to Sevenoaks. They cycled up to the start at Sevenoaks Prep School and then completed the 40km course before enjoying the lunch provided by the organisers.

They then cycled back to the station, caught the train back to London and returned their bikes to the stands. Hire of bike for the day £50. They even cycled up Carters Hill and you can see in the photo that their challenge was not only cycling with a bike that is somewhat heavy and has only three gears but they decided to do it wearing business clothes as well.
