LONDON 1 SOUTH: Sevenoaks 16 Brighton Blues 12

In the first of what promise to be two compelling home and away installments, Sevenoaks Rugby enjoyed a dogged 16 points to 12 win in the rain and wind at a sodden Knole Paddock on Saturday against their visitors from the South coast.

Brighton arrived in Kent full of pomp and puffed at the chest from five wins on the trot as the leading point scorers at the top of London 1 South. They returned home diminished in stature and second in the League, with a losing bonus point the solitary reward for playing out their part in an enthralling encounter and having taken the game to Sevenoaks during certain periods in the match.

Two acts, one elemental and the other existential, played telling roles in proceedings.

First to the elements; the rain lashed spitefully, relentlessly and indiscriminately against players, coaches and spectators, confining the expansive ambitions of both teams, with the wings of Blues' rapid and lively counter rugby decisively clipped on a day when the ball

represented the proverbial bar of soap.

Second, the existential: after one of those thumping tackles that are the trademark of Gumbleton, captain on the day for the Oaks, the Brighton number 8 took out his frustration with some instinctive and certainly not premeditated footwork as his boot made contact with the head of the Oaks defender.

There is only one sanction available to the referee in such instances, and having seen red once the Brighton 8 saw red again, which at least gave him the

consolation (given the conditions) of 'an early bath'.

The impact of Brighton's reduction to 14 men was not immediate. Indeed Oaks had crashed over for a try when the playing numbers were still even - having battered the Brighton try line for several plays in succession, Adams slotting the extras. But it will have been felt over the full eighty minutes when the pack in particular had to play as one, which Oaks did in a concerted team effort that says much about the commitment of this band of brothers. Before the match, Coach Bowman asked his men to "go to the well" and their performance showed they did just that.

The two sides also exchanged penalties prior to the break, which meant they re-emerged for the second half with the navy and golds 10-3 to the good.

What ensued was a 40-minute slug-fest, as the teams used tight five play and the legitimate boot (to ball) to establish field position. All the time you sensed Brighton's threat from anywhere on the park, while Adams kept the visitors at bay as he secured a further penalty to take the Oaks tally to 13 with Brighton duly responding, making it 13-9 with the game very much afoot.

Oaks then made the winning incursion into the Brighton half, and by being patient at a sequence of rucks and mauls they foraged their way forward to within five yards of their opponents' try line before Brighton killed the ball illegally, and from the resulting penalty in front of the posts Adams duly slotted the ball over; 16-9.

If the Oaks faithful thought that was the game, they were sorely mistaken as Brighton never give up and roared back to reduce the deficit to 16-12. On the attack, looking menacing, and with the shadow of last season's Blues win in the last play of the game casting its way eerily across the Paddock, the Blues drove up field only to be penalised for hanging on to the ball too long. The thrilling encounter was drawn to a close by Oaks hoofing the ball off the park as the Home balcony erupted in applause for the win and in respect for two teams who had done their utmost in uncompromising conditions.

All teams in London 1 South look forward to a well-earned break this coming weekend. In a quirk of results, despite winning Oaks dropped down to fifth in the League on points difference. They are equal-pegged on 24 points with two other sides including Westcombe Park, where Oaks head for their next League match on Saturday 20 October, 3:00pm Kick off and all support very welcome.

Ide Hill suffer their first loss since March

Ide Hill slumped to their first defeat of the season on Saturday afternoon, going down 2-1 to South East Athletic in the First Round of the Challenge Cup.

Ide Hill, who were never really at the races, deservedly went behind after 15 minutes of concerted pressure from the visitors, with South East seizing on a multitude of errors and Darren Wynne firing in off the post from 20 yards.

Ide Hill rallied and enjoyed a good share of the subsequent possession and chances, with Callum Heath purposeful once more out wide and Matthew Bunn foraging and creating half chances for the team.

South East probably should have been further in front at the break, with the hosts escaping from a number of goal mouth scrambles in their own 6 yard box to gratefully get in to the interval at just 1-0 down.

The Ide hill defence, led by Ben Pearson and Luke Steggles, battled hard to keep the league leaders in the game against strong South East forwards who both exhibited excellent link up play.

Tom Wright worked tirelessly up front on his return to the starting line up, whilst George Kensell and Jaymes Randall provided strong width and support for the defence.

Joe Baker came on in the second half and provided vocal authority and aerial strength, whilst Sam Heasman pressed with energy and ran beyond the South East defence with purpose.

Ide Hill were gifted a chance to pull themselves level on the hour mark, though, as a soft penalty was awarded for pushing in the box following a corner. However, Craig Jackson could not capitalise, screwing a poor penalty wide to keep the visitors ahead as the clock ran down.

This miss was punished further as South East doubled their lead with ten minutes left, good build up play resulting in Barry Ryan firing in to the top corner from 10 yards out. Mike Mckay, who had a busy afternoon, played well and could do nothing about either of South East Athletic's goals.

Ide Hill were rewarded for some concerted late pressure though, as Heath broke down the right and slid a perfect square ball across the penalty box to Jackson, who stepped inside the defender and slotted beyond the keeper with 5 minutes left.

However, the goal turned out to be little more than a consolation, as South East Athletic saw out the remaining minutes to progress through to the next round.

A disappointing afternoon's work for Ide Hill, with the only solace coming with the fact that their league results remain unblemished, but knowing they will need to perform much better against other title rivals if they are to continue their good start through the winter.

Sevenoaks defend well to earn their first point

Sevenoaks got their first point of the season on Sunday afternoon in a hard-fought encounter with Brooklands. The Manchester side arrived at Hollybush Lane, like Sevenoaks, on zero points after two games, making this a key game for both sides, even at this early point in the season.

Brooklands got off to a dream start when they earned a penalty corner after three minutes, finding a Sevenoaks foot in the D. From the resulting set piece they took the lead as the drag-flick found its way past Richard Potton in the Sevenoaks goal and Craig Morton standing on the post to put the visitors 1-0 up.

Oaks responded well and enjoyed some good spells of possession without really testing the Brooklands goalkeeper. Brooklands nearly doubled their lead when a long aerial pass saw the create an opportunity in the Sevenoaks D, but a combination of Potton and 17 year old debutant Ben Fox kept the ball out the Sevenoaks net.

Sevenoaks earned a penalty corner midway through the half but Andrew Ross saw his flick turned round the post by the defender on the line. Oaks did draw level though soon after when excellent pressing by eventual Man of the Match Nick Barker saw him steal the ball from the Brooklands defender and feed the ball to Duncan Parnis who cooly slotted past the advancing keeper to make it 1-1.

As half time approached Brooklands had their second penalty corner of the game and a well worked move saw

Potton have to make a fine save from a deflection. On the stroke of half-time Oaks missed another penalty corner and the sides went into the break at 1-1.

The second half became slightly disjointed with both sides seeing a couple of players sent to the sin-bin.

Brooklands had another penalty corner but were unable to convert, whilst Tom Graham had the best opportunity for Sevenoaks from open play, as he eliminated three players to get into a shooting position but his effort was tame and easily kicked away by the keeper.

Sevenoaks had yet another penalty corner of their own but Ross's effort was well saved by the diving keeper. Both sides threatened but neither could really create anything clear cut, and as the clock ticked down it looked more and more like the score would remain tied.

The last play of the game saw an aerial

pass collected by Ali Taylor and as he drove towards the D he was taken out by the Brooklands defender and a penalty corner was awarded just before the final whistle was blown giving Oaks one last chance to grab all three points at the death.

Unfortunately it wasn't to be as a misplaced pass saw the routine break down and Oaks couldn't even get a shot away on goal, so the final score remained 1-1.

There was some disappointment from Sevenoaks at the end of the game that one point was not three, but Brooklands probably shared those feelings, meaning ultimately a draw was probably the right result.

Oaks will welcome Hampstead & Westminster to Hollybush Lane next Sunday at 2pm, and will meet a side in great form having won all three of their opening games thus far.
