Mayoral occasion lifts Oaks despite no win

England Hockey Mens Premier League: Sevenoaks 2 East Grinstead 2

Sevenoaks ended the first half of the Premier League season with a 2-2 draw against East Grinstead on Saturday night as the two sides played out an entertaining match in front of a bumper crowd including the Mayors of both Sevenoaks and East Grinstead, and Sevenoaks District Council Chairman Cllr Pat Bosley.

Oaks started the game on the front foot and in the opening 10 minutes they won a penalty corner but were unable to convert. East Grinstead replied with a reverse stick shot from wide left in the D that Richard Potton did well to turn over the crossbar. Oaks were the side who looked most likely to open the scoring though, as first Tim Warrington had a chance from close range that was well saved by the goalkeeper's trailing leg, and then Duncan Parnis saw his shot smothered by the keeper from 5 yards out. The game was delayed 10 minutes as the floodlights temporarily switched off, but that didn't take the spark out of the game, and as half time approached Oaks nearly took the lead when a turnover deep in the East Grinstead half saw Ali Taylor blast a



reverse stick effort wide when anything on target would have been a near certain goal. The sides went into the break locked together at 0-0.

After the break, East Grinstead took the lead from a penalty corner to make it 1-O. The Oaks reaction was good and they went straight down the other end and won a penalty corner of their own, but as has so often been the case this season they couldn't find the back of the net from the set piece. Midway through second half East Grinstead were reduced to 10 men for 5 minutes as their midfielder was sent to the sinbin and Oaks took full advantage. Firstly the

Sevenoaks man of the match Gurmukh Bhamra skilfully won another penalty corner, which Parnis converted to draw the sides level at 1-1, and then a minute later Oaks took a 2-1 lead when Ed Matts tapped in at the far post after good work from Ben Fox. Unfortunately for Sevenoaks the lead was to be short lived as East Grinstead almost immediately won a penalty corner of their own and converted to bring the sides level again at 2-2 with 10 minutes remaining. Both sides had opportunities to win the game in the closing few minutes but neither side could take them, and the game ended in a 2-2 draw.

The point takes Oaks onto three points, and they remain bottom of the table as the league heads into a winter break until February. Oaks will feel like they dropped two points having led with only 12 minutes remaining, but the level of performance was encouraging and should send them into the break with confidence that they can compete with every team in the league and there are plenty of points still to be won.

A subsection of the squad will now compete in the Indoor Premier League in December and January – as Oaks look to qualify for finals night for the 4th time in five years.

Charity Cup reward for Ide Hill after eight goals

Sevenoaks Senior Charity Cup: Ightham 1 Ide Hill 8

Ide Hill avenged last year's semi-final cup loss by despatching rivals Ightham with ease on Saturday in the Sevenoaks Senior Charity Cup.

Missing numerous players due to injury and suspension, Ide Hill's squad was relatively thin in comparison to normal, with Jack Heasmann called up from the reserves in to the heart of the defence and club stalwart Bazil Pennells making his first appearance of the season from the bench.

Always a game which contains a degree of needle, Ide Hill started fast in an attempt to put Ightham away early and took the lead within 10 minutes; a Columb Grant corner was helped on at the near post and tucked away by centre half Luke Steggles for his second of the season.

Ide Hill doubled their lead minutes later, Craig Jackson surging into the box and cutting back to Grant, who volleyed into the far corner from 18 yards.

Ide Hill then made it three on the hour as wing back Sam Heasmann slipped Matt Bunn through on the left, who slotted beneath the onrushing Ightham goalkeeper.

George Kensell then took centre stage to register a brilliant hat trick to take the game away from the opposition. His first arrived when a Rob Piper cross resulted in a goalmouth scramble; the ball falling Kensell's way in the box, allowing him to slot into the corner. His second came via a long

range shot, fired across the keeper and into the side netting from 20 yards. He saved the best for last though in his man of the match performance; substitute Pennells crossing to him from the right, which Kensell met on the volley from 18 yards.

Pennells then arguably topped all of the goals, receiving the ball 25 yards out in the centre and hitting an unstoppable strike into the top corner for number seven. Bunn rounded things off by scoring his own and taking his tally to seven for the season; he ran the ball to the edge of the box on the right and whipped a fierce low strike across the goalkeeper and into the corner for eight. Ightham managed a late consolation, a left footed free kick curled round the wall and into the bottom corner to finish the scoring at 8-1.

So Ide Hill go into the next round; next week they have more cup commitments facing Cuxton in the Kent Intermediate Challenge Shield before returning to league action.

Incidentally, they are now only three points clear at the top with one game in hand over second place, as Chipstead beat title rivals Sydenham Sports to tighten everything up even further at the top of the table.

Sevenoaks hold their own in UK Premiership challenge

Sevenoaks Town FC's Powerchair team returned to Nottingham Trent University during November and secured another wins as they make a statement about their intentions for the rest of the season.

Unfortunately Sevenoaks have lost nine of their opening 14 matches this season, but the competition is much tougher in the Premier League and they have definetely not been embarrassed by any other club.

Last gasp winner for Mighty Oaks over Havant

London 1 South: Havant 33 Sevenoaks 34

Sevenoaks Rugby Club returned from the South coast on Saturday with a bonus point win, following a last gasp 34-33 away victory at Havant RFC.

Trailing 27-33 at the end of the match with the clock in red zone territory, Sevenoaks dug deep, punted a penalty to the corner and from the lineout brought closure to a game that appeared to have slipped away. How did it come to this? Such a precarious position was all but unthinkable five minutes into the match. Oaks, in formidable form, opened at a canter with a brace of converted tries, one for Dan Power – enjoying his 100th Oaks cap – and one for Matt McCrae, both duly converted by Ben Adams. The visitors were finding the magic carpet ride of a 3G pitch much to their liking.

Havant, though, has developed a knack of winning over Oaks at Hooks Lane. They sensed that the navy and gold battle rhythm was there to be disrupted and as they hit their stride the game took on a more frantic tempo.

Havant drove, carried and offloaded with precision to take themselves into a 23-14 lead at the break, capitalising on Oaks' errors. The pause gave Oaks a welcome opportunity to lean in to the coaches' half-time chat and take stock.

The ensuing forty minutes were relentless and highly entertaining, as everyone following the match was kept on the edge of their proverbial seats. At one stage a Mike Scott try took Oaks into the lead, only for Havant to strike back and take a 33-27 lead with time all but up.

So it was that in the dying embers of the match, Sevenoaks finally grabbed the game with both hands; the catch from the lineout, a maul and a rumble through a sequence of pick and goes saw Josh Pettet pile over for the try before Adams calmly slotted the conversion for the win.

After the match, a clearly relieved Head Coach Adam Bowman said, "Quite frankly, I'm not sure how we won that. We were dead and buried with three minutes to go and the character and control the boys showed at the end were excellent. We continued to trust the systems and processes we have in place

and we executed effectively. We knew coming into this game that Havant's League position didn't reflect what a quality outfit they were – they will shoot up the League and not many sides will win at Hooks Lane this season. While of course we are delighted with the five-point win, the performance was below the standards and expectations we set ourselves as a squad. We have to improve if we are to maintain and build on our current League position and will be working hard this week to ensure we are much improved before Dartfordians."

Whilst Havant Head Coach Will Knight had this to say about Sevenoaks: "They are good side on a winning run and you could see that confidence in their play, I would fully expect them to be right there in the mix at the end of the season."

This Saturday the Paddock hosts Oaks v Dartfordians in London 1 South, 2:00pm kick off and all support welcome with both the 2nd's and 3rd's also in home action.
