### London 1 South: Tottonians 10 Sevenoaks 26

Sevenoaks RFC 1st XV produced a bonus-point winning performance away to Tottonians to maintain their position at the top of London South 1. That position in first place is shared with Medway RFC, a team Oaks will face in two weeks' time at the Paddock in a tantalising fixture.

Oaks travelled to Totton in fine fettle, with an almost fully fit squad to choose from and on the back of beating local rivals Westcombe Park in their previous fixture.

On a heavy pitch, but in clear conditions, Oaks kicked off full of

confidence and eager to make a mark early on in the game.

Almost immediately, that plan was thrown out the window and within a minute the men from the Paddock were 7-0 down as Tottonians took advantage of a defensive lapse in the Oaks ranks to score a good try on the right hand wing. The home side full back stroked over a fine conversion to the delight of the home crowd and completed a perfect start.

Despite the visitors then working their way up the field into Tottonian territory, Oaks were unable to make the pressure count, largely in part to the excellent home defence and willingness to put their bodies on the line.

Oaks' frustrations grew as firstly number 8 Alex Suttie was denied a try by the referee, who deemed the ball was held up on the line. Two minutes later, the home side's full back stroked over a penalty after Oaks had been deemed to be offside. 10-0 to the home side and the away support were getting somewhat concerned.

But Oaks' pressure was starting to tell as the home side continued to give away penalties for various offences. It allowed Oaks to gain field position and momentum. From a line out close to the Totts line, the Oaks pack drove their opponents back with force and hooker

## Ide Hill Boyle over to reach Charity Cup semi-finals

### Sevenoak Charity Senior Cup: Ide Hill 2 Southborough 1

Shaun Boyle climbed off the bench to strike an 80th minute winner that saw Ide Hill move into the Semi Finals of the Sevenoaks Charity Senior Cup on Saturday afternoon at Wrotham School.

Still missing a number of key defenders, the Kent County side's manager Paul McDonagh opted to play two midfielders in central defence alongside Charlie James, with Ben Holder, and Man of the Match, George Kensell turning in excellent and committed performances out of position.

Southborough proved to be a physically strong side from the Sevenoaks & District Premier Division, and it became clear quite quickly that the game would be a tight one, with Ide Hill only flickering with the quality that has propelled them to the top of their division.

The home team had an effort cleared off the line in the 10th minute when Matt Bunn lifted his effort over the onrushing goalkeeper only to see his shot swept away by the defender. Ide Hill were producing some slick openings on the

break and it was one such combination that brought the opening goal. Bunn was this time the provider, feeding Tom Wright in to the penalty area 10 minutes later and the returning striker took his chance, coolly side-footing into the bottom right corner to give Hill the lead.

The game continued evenly into the break, Southborough growing in confidence especially with the aerial threat they carried and the dangerous long throw routine which spread some panic. They deservedly drew level on the hour mark, Jack Parrot latching on to a long ball over the top and firing beneath Mike McKay for the equaliser.

With extra time looming, the game was in the balance, and there was the feel that it was going to head in that direction. Boyle then missed a gilt edged one-on-one when breaking clean through, his rolled effort just going the wrong side of the post. Bunn also passed up a couple of decent chances, rolling just wide from the penalty spot and not quite getting enough power on a cut back to trouble the goalkeeper. Southborough will also feel they should have taken one from their dangerous set piece routines.

But it was substitute Boyle who had the last word, Jack Edmeads finding him in a congested box in the 80th minute, he steadied himself and volleyed home the winner, which flashed in with the keeper helpless. Manager McDonagh was ultimately satisfied with the victory, saying: "It was hard fought, Southborough are a tough, physical side and we really had to grind it out, even when not playing particularly well."

Talking of Kensell's colossal performance at the back, he added: "He was brilliant, with a few defenders missing he really stood up for the side. Not just in his defensive work which was excellent, but also his distribution which was good throughout."

Ide Hill progress to the Semi Finals where they will play Farnborough Old Boys Guild, and with a chance of silverware looming on the horizon, they'll definitely be hoping to be back to their very best.

Meanwhile, Ide Hill's league competitors, Sydenham Sports and Chipstead, both won at the weekend to narrow Hill's lead at the top of the league, tightening the title race to the end as they all enter their final five games.



# Sevenoaks in urgent need of a great escape

**England Hockey Mens Premier League: Sevenoaks 2 University of Exeter 3**

For the second week in a row Sevenoaks threw away a half-time lead to come out on the wrong end of a 3-2 scoreline, this time at home to fellow strugglers University of Exeter. In what was a must-win game, the defeat now means Sevenoaks are four points adrift at the bottom of the Premier League with only six games remaining and require a great escape to avoid relegation.

Sevenoaks made a bright start and won a couple of early penalty corners, but unfortunately couldn't take advantage of these. Exeter responded with a penalty corner of their own, and were more clinical than Oak, slotting the ball into the back of the net to make it 1-0 to the visitors.

The Sevenoaks response was good and four minutes later they were on level terms, when Ed Matts nicked the ball off the Exeter defender and the ball fell to Ali Taylor who was fouled in the D and a penalty stroke was awarded. Andrew Ross stepped up and converted the penalty to make it 1-1 after 16 minutes. Oaks continued to have the better of the first half, winning a couple more penalty corners, the second of which was scored by Andrew Ross just before half-time to give Oaks a 2-1 lead at the break.

Early in the second half, Oaks won another penalty corner but were wasteful

again, not getting a proper shot away. Midway through the half a turnover deep in Sevenoaks territory gave the Exeter forward a free run on goal and he was able to slip underneath the advancing Richard Potton in the Oaks goal to level the scores at 2-2.

The remainder of the game consisted of Oaks pressing forwards, dominating possession, and Exeter playing on the counter attack. This was how the game was to be settled – with one minute remaining on the clock, Oaks were in an advanced position and the ball was played into Nick Barker on the edge of the D. He was clattered into by an untidy

Exeter challenge – but no foul was given due to a supposed advantage which came to nothing.

Exeter then threw an aerial pass downfield and the forward received, squared across goal for another forward to slide in and finish to make the score 3-2. A sucker punch for Oaks who had dominated large portions of the game, and once again conceded in the closing stages of the game to lose 3-2.

Oaks will now need to pull off an astonishing escape to avoid relegation. They travel to second placed Hampstead and Westminster next week to try and cause an upset.



## Suns ton-up with Trophy win on the road at Rebels

**WBBL Trophy: Essex Rebels 58 Sevenoaks Suns 101**

Sevenoaks Suns concluded the group phase of the Trophy with a 101-58 victory over Essex Rebels, at Essex Sports Arena on Sunday evening.

The Suns will now face Leicester Riders in the next round, having qualified for the Semi-Finals with a perfect 4-0 group record. Essex meanwhile must wait until next season to get off the mark in the competition, having failed to pick up a victory this time around.

Sevenoaks wasted no time establishing their dominance on proceedings, racing out to a 20-point

lead after the opening 10 minutes to all but end Essex's hopes of a shock result.

The Rebels were unable to keep pace with Sevenoaks' offence from the outset and the visitors poured in more than 25 points in each of the first three quarters of the game, allowing the Suns to surpass the 100-point barrier before the final buzzer sounded.

## Town jubilant after win in the Channel Islands

Sevenoaks travelled to Guernsey for the first time in their history and put on a great second half performance as Ainsley Everett came off the bench and struck twice to overturn a half-time deficit.

Guernsey took the lead inside eight minutes of the match through Dave Rihoy, his left-footed rising drive looked like it was going to be a routine fingertip save from Louie Catherall to divert the ball over his bar, but the Sevenoaks stopper instead failed to get a strong enough touch and let the ball past him into the net.

Almost all of Sevenoaks' opportunities were restricted to efforts from outside the area in the first half as Alex Fiddes dragged a low one wide and twice fired over the top in quick succession. Frankie Sawyer was also off-target twice when running onto a long ball into the right channel.

Midway through the second half Guernsey failed to clear their lines from a free-kick, and substitute Everett pounced on a loose ball to fire through the crowd. The ball struck the far post and crept over the line for the equaliser.

Sevenoaks then pushed forward, and Guernsey lost another goal, and a man, in the 77th minute. Frank Tobin hauled

down Sawyer as he ran onto a through ball and there was no surprise when the centre-back was shown a straight red as the last man. The resulting free-kick was a peach as Everett picked out the far corner with the home goalkeeper unable to reach it.

Guernsey lacked fluidity in the closing stages and Sevenoaks should have had another deep into stoppage-time as Sawyer centred for Tommy Whitnell, but the forward somehow succeeded in diverting the ball over from a yard out.

All in all, a great afternoon for the travelling team and supporters. Town sit 10th in the Bostik League South East and play Ramsgate at home this Saturday.
