Hundreds turn out to cheer on league leaders

London 1 South: Sevenoaks 22 Medway 16

Sevenoaks Rugby secured a hard fought 22-16 home win over Medway on Saturday as a 500-strong crowd was served up one of the most entertainingly competitive matches to grace the Paddock in recent memory.

There was plenty of added spice in the mix as both sets of players stepped out to play some truly outstanding rugby.

Going into the match the two sides were level on points at the top of London

1 South League, which is entering the final furlongs of a testing season.

In the sixteen matches played between them at various league levels since the late 1980s, these teams had won eight apiece. And there was also a special guest on the touch line in the shape of Chris Kelly, President, the RFU.

The match started at a ferocious tempo as the teams tussled for territory in combative early exchanges and seldom has space on a 100 by 70 metre patch of grass been so resolutely defended.

Medway showed fantastic ball retention and looked dangerous in their ambition to move the ball quickly from any part of the field. Oaks had a slightly more free flowing dynamic with ball in hand and were relentless in their defensive squeeze.

In such tight matches discipline comes to the fore and Oaks were frequently adjudged offside after being slightly too eager in the press in penalty kicking territory.

Fortunately the reliability of the Medway kicker who slotted three from four in the first 30 minutes was equalled by Oaks' metronomic Ben Adams who kept Oaks in touch to make it 9-6 to the visitors entering the final moments of the first half when Sevenoaks outside half Leighton Ralph cut through the Medway line from inside his own half. The mesmerising interplay that followed resulted in Nigel Gumbleton diving over for a try that Adams converted to take Oaks into the sheds with a 13-9 advantage.

Medway came back fast and hard in the second half and finally found a gap in Oaks defensive set up to score a converted try and take a deserved 16-13 lead into the final quarter.

Oaks responded by upping the energy level yet again and supported by

excellent tactical kicking from hand, took advantage of the wind at their backs with composed kicking from the tee by Adams who took Oaks into a 22-16 lead with three consecutive successful penalties. The third was a beauty from just inside the Medway half that sailed high through the uprights and beyond the car park behind the posts with 20 metres to spare.

Medway remained determined to make a mark on proceedings and for every second of the last five minutes hammered at the Oaks try line, camped inside the Oaks 22. However the courageous home team mentality and solid scrummaging kept the Oaks line in tact. As another massive hit forced a Medway knock on, time was called and the crowd erupted in applause for the win and in recognition of a phenomenal spectacle of a match where both teams gave everything and more.

Sevenoaks and Medway as well as vying for supremacy in an incredibly tight division are also two Clubs investing in youth and depth, and one sign of this was to see them bucking the trend by fielding four senior sides apiece against each other on Saturday afternoon; although a regular feature in the 1990s such a scene of the same two Clubs playing one another with two squads at home and two away is too rarely repeated these days.

Across the four Oaks v Medway matches the navy and golds 1s, 2s and 3s secured victories over Medway to whom the Gents/4s lost out. Rugby in Kent is alive and well.

Oaks now hold the narrowest of leads in the League and face another stern test this Saturday against Camberley away - 3:00pm kick off and with Camberley just three points behind Oaks, all support is very welcome.

RFU President praises 'impressive' Sevenoaks

The President of the RFU, Chris Kelly, found time in his extremely busy schedule to attend his first ever match at the Paddock, thanks to an invite from Sevenoaks RFC ever-present Robert Horner, once President of the RFU himself during the 2003/04 season. And he couldn't have picked a better fixture – the

match between 1st and 2nd in the London 1 South, Sevenoaks versus Medway. Kelly enjoyed the wonderful hospitality the club always put on and over 80 club members and guests were given a memorable speech after their lunch in the Clubhouse.

Sevenoaks Sports caught up with Kelly after the pulsating

match and we asked him what he thought about his day in Sevenoaks, he responded: "This is a great club, it's an impressive club! For a club like Sevenoaks, and indeed Medway too, to be putting out four senior teams against each other is marvellous.

"It was an outstanding game of rugby today, two very

good teams with tremendous defences. It could have gone either way, but the long range kick for Sevenoaks probably won it in the end."

Kelly had obviously done his homework on Sevenoaks as he added: "It reminds you that it is a community game, clubs are all about volunteers and rugby is all about friendship. Youngsters won't play if people don't give up their time, and the fact Sevenoaks has over 900 kids playing on a Sunday morning is testament to that."

Talking openly, Kelly commented on England's loss to Wales in Cardiff the previous week: "With the Welsh team, they are great rivals in rugby, but as people, they're mates. So we have to grin and bear it, if you lose you lose.

"I don't write off Eddie [Jones] and the boys, I think they've got a good side and they'll be there or thereabouts for the World Cup."



No Trophy Final, but league remains flawless for Suns

WBBL Championship:
Durham Palatinates 54
Sevenoaks Suns 70

Sevenoaks Suns bounced back after the crushing disappointment of missing out on the 2019 Trophy Final via Saturday's Semi-Final loss to Leicester Riders, and it took them no time at all.

They were able to get back on track and consolidate top spot in the standings and remain flawless with success over Durham Palatinates. They have now cemented their status as the favourites to be crowned WBBL Championship winners again.

Sevenoaks turned the defensive screw in the third period once again and held Durham to a paltry six points.

They then came up with 17 big offensive rebounds in the

contest, whilst Ta'Yani Clark claimed a stellar triple-double, this time accumulating 13 points, 17 rebounds and 11 assists.

Leading scorers for Suns were: Jess Good (16), Renee Busch (15) and Clark (13).

WBBL Trophy Semi-Final:
Leicester Riders 75
Sevenoaks Suns 69 - after overtime.

Sevenoaks headed to Leicester on Saturday as favourites for the WBBL Trophy, however they succumbed to the defending champions in overtime, finally going down 70-65.

Riders have now won seven games in a row in what was a repeat of last season's final, and will meet Durham Palatinates this time around

on Sunday 10 March in the final.

A three-pointer gave Riders the lead with a minute to play in regulation but, fittingly between the league's top two, overtime was forced by Julia Koppl, and she initially put Suns up in the extra period.

But Leicester turned that around attacking the basket

with 20 seconds to play to give them a 68-65 edge that proved to be enough.

Leicester were much more accurate from long-range as they shot 9-24 (37%) from beyond the arc, compared to Suns at 4-24 (16%).

Leading scorers for Suns were: Jess Good (24), Cat Carr (12) and Koppl (10).



Relegation looms for battling Sevenoaks Hockey team

England Hockey Mens Premier Division: Sevenoaks 0 Wimbledon 6

Sevenoaks moved one step closer to relegation from the Premier League on Saturday after a 6-0 defeat to Wimbledon. This coupled with Exeter beating Brooklands means Oaks now sit eight points adrift at the bottom of the table with 4 games remaining.

Based on league positions, the game against Wimbledon should have been a close one, with Wimbledon sitting in 8th place and Sevenoaks in 10th place. However, Wimbledon's league position does not reflect the strength of their squad. For most the season they have been missing their five current Great Britain internationals, but they were all back in the team for the game against Sevenoaks making Wimbledon a very different proposition.

The influx of quality saw Wimbledon get off to a fast start, opening the scoring after 5 minutes from a penalty corner. A quick fire double in the 12th and 13th minute saw them extend their lead to 3-0. Oaks had a couple of good

opportunities to get back into the game, but Andrew Ross missed a penalty stroke, after David Smith was felled in the D, and Tim Warrington couldn't get his shot away after being played in by Ed Matts. Oaks were made to pay for their profligacy when Wimbledon converted a penalty corner rebound to make it 4-0 after 24 minutes. That was how the score remained until half time.

Oaks responded well in the second half and never gave up. They had some good

chances to pull a goal back but finishing let them down in key moments. Wimbledon continued to threaten but largely Oaks contained them until a 60 second blitz midway through the half saw Wimbledon add two goals to their tally to make the score 6-0, which was how it remained until full time.

Sevenoaks now face Holcombe next week at home and will have to win that game to stand any hope of retaining their place in the Premier League.
