### Life in top flight is nearly over for Purple Army

#### England Hockey League Mens Premier Division: Sevenoaks 1 Holcombe 3

Whilst Sevenoaks are still not mathematically relegated defeat to Holcombe on Saturday evening means they must now win each of their last three games and hope that Exeter get nothing from their remaining three games. Given Sevenoaks still have to play league leaders Surbiton and they've failed to register a win all season, the odds are somewhat stacked against them.

Despite a positive start on Saturday, a familiar pattern played out as their visitors scored with practically their first foray into the Sevenoaks defensive D. A mix up between defender and goalkeeper saw the loose ball drop to a forward lurking nearby, who gratefully accepted the ball and flicked into an empty net to put Holcombe 1-0 up after only four minutes. Oaks rallied and had

a lot of ball in the following few minutes, and pressure told when an excellent run by Chris Barker along the left hand baseline saw him pull the ball back to Tim Warrington to finished first time into the backboard to draw the sides level at 1-1 after eight minutes. The remainder of the half was a relatively even affair with Oaks looking threatening whilst rarely forcing the Holcombe keeper into action. Holcombe has the better chances with a string of penalty corners but they couldn't convert any of them, and the half-time score remained 1-1.

The second half continued with both sides pushing and probing for victory. Midway through the half an Oaks attack broke down on the edge of the Holcombe D with a loose pass. The subsequent counter attack saw Holcombe win a penalty corner which they converted to make the score 2-1. These are the fine margins that Oaks have faced all season

- being on the edge of the opponents D one second, looking dangerous in attack before loosing possession and conceding moments later. Oaks responded positively and earned a penalty corner but a mis-trap at the top of the D meant they were unable to get a shot away. Within a minute the game was beyond them as a hopeful ball forwards from Holcombe somehow eluded three Oaks players before finding their forward in the Oaks D. The forward slipped the ball sideways to his strike partner who tapped into the empty net to make the score 3-1. Sevenoaks pushes and pushed for a way back into the game but they couldn't break through, and the final score remained 3-1.

Oaks now travel to Brooklands in Manchester next weekend and depending on results their relegation could be confirmed come Sunday afternoon.



# Ide Hill make a point as league goes down to the wire

Ide Hill battled back from 3-1 down to grab a more than deserved draw in the top of the table clash at Sydenham on Saturday afternoon.

Ide Hill went into the game knowing that a positive result, with only five games remaining, would put them in the driving seat for winning the league.

They also welcomed back crucial defenders for the showdown in skipper Phil Alteirac and defensive lynchpin Ben Pearson, whilst Josh Howard was given his first start and delivered a strong performance from left wing back.

Ide Hill got off to a poor start in their biggest game of the season, playing into a swirling wind and on a tight pitch, a ball was floated in behind the defence out to the right and Kane Jones ran on to lift beyond the advancing Mike McKay for a 1-0 lead within 10 minutes.

It was a frantic start, with little football being played by either side in difficult conditions, but the visitors eased themselves back in to proceedings, knitting some cutting attacks together to get in behind the Sydenham defence. Ide Hill pulled level after 25 minutes, Ben Holder found himself out on the right wing after keeping a set play alive, he waited and floated a sumptuous cross in to the back post where Alteirac was waiting to fire a header in to the corner for the equaliser.

Ide Hill then stepped on the gas for the remainder of the half, playing some good football and carving out a number of chances that could have taken them in front.

George Kensell, excellent again out wide, found himself in the six yard box but snatched at his chance and fired over with his left foot. Pearson then headed over from close range when well placed.

Ide Hill headed into the break buoyed and feeling this was their game to win, but this optimism was quickly punctured within 10 manic minutes after the break.

Giant forward Oliver Bell caused problems with his aerial ability throughout, nodding his first in direct from a set play on 50 minutes then scoring a clever lob on the hour mark to take Sydenham towards seeming victory and a five point lead at the top of the table.

But Ide Hill showed their mettle in the final half hour, refusing to wilt and cede their league title charge. They pulled one back after 70 minutes, Jack Edmeads driving into the box and drawing the foul, which Craig Jackson tucked away for his 13th of the season.

The visitors continued to exert pressure chasing the equaliser, Luke Steggle passing up two good chances when raiding from left back, firing over with his left on the volley from 10 yards and not able to apply the finish when driving in to a one on one from the left.

Ide Hill deservedly found the equaliser in the 80th minute though, an Edmeads floated free kick was perfectly placed to cause havoc and the keeper missed it, allowing it to go straight in for 3-3 and his 7th of the season.

Ide Hill then had a chance in the final minutes ruled offside for the returning Rob Piper and the game ended in a slightly comical manner, forward George Harris played through, spurning his chance, however the referee blew for the final whistle as he took his touch in the box, much to the ire of the home team.

Manager Paul McDonagh was relatively pleased with the point; "it was a messy game, they were a big physical side and the playing conditions were tough. But we showed character and did well to pull the game back around when two down. We probably deserved to win on chances created, but will take the point and it leaves us in a good position" and on Man of the Match Phil Alteirac: "It was great to have him back, he took his goal well and made a big difference having him back in the defence".

Ide Hill remain in a strong position in the league with four games left to play. They are two points behind Sydenham with two games in hand.

Next week Ide Hill have the chance to reclaim top spot with a win at Long Lane as the other top sides are not in action. All still to play for in what has been a thrilling title race and an excellent season for Ide Hill.

## Chipstead ignite the fire beneath

Chipstead FC kept up with their Division One West opponents as they despatched Stansfeld (O&B) Reserves 6-1 on Saturday afternoon in Chislehurst. Three braces from Mitchell Hill, Bradley Setters and Chris Steadman ensured that the race for the title will keep going until the final four games.

# Oaks grab bonus point in loss to Camberley

London 1 South: Camberley 17  
Sevenoaks 11

Sevenoaks RFC 1st XV's twelve game winning streak came to an end on Saturday as they were beaten 17-11 away at Camberley RFC. After leading at half time by one point, in front of a vocal and full crowd, the home side scored a converted try and penalty to move away from Oaks, before a Ben Adams penalty concluded the scoring and ensured that Oaks went away with what could be a crucial bonus point.

With both teams competing at the top of the league and separated by only three points, onlookers knew that it was going to be a close contest and so it proved. With a strong wind going across the pitch, the opening stanza saw handling errors from both sides as they tried to assert authority on the other. Despite Camberley having greater territory, Oaks struck first, as winger Ben Adams picked off the home full back's pass inside the Oaks 22 before sprinting the length and stepping inside the covering defender to score a try which he was unable to convert. 5-0 to Oaks.

When Oaks had the ball, they looked dangerous and from the kick off, full back Jonny Short nearly scythed through before being hauled down. Sharp breaks by Leighton Ralph, Matt Holmes and Richard Adenyi-Jones went unrewarded as the final pass and excellent home defence denied further scores. Indeed as the half went on, Camberley began to gather momentum, particularly at scrum time. A scrum five metres out from Oaks line led to the home side's first score - after a number of re-sets the referee awarded Camberley a penalty try for Oaks continually infringing and Power was sent to the sin bin. The automatic seven points put Camberley in the lead by 7-5.

With a few minutes of the first half left on the clock and back to a full complement, Oaks began to put phases together and from a penalty that was kicked to the corner. The away side's catch and drive from the lineout was thwarted illegally, resulting in another yellow card, but this time to the home side loose head prop. Moments later, after another infringement and with half time looming, Oaks decided to kick the

straightforward penalty to go 8-7 up at the break. A chance for both sides to regather themselves and an opportunity for supporters to catch their breath.

Camberley began the second half stronger and struck with a second score through the excellent Allen. Some good hands by the pacy Camberley backs enabled them to get on the outside of the Oaks defence to release Allen who finished well. The home fly-half Smart converted and the score was back in the home side's favour, 14-8.

Despite difficulties at the scrum, Oaks continued to work their way up the pitch, with Number 8 Sean Derrick to the fore - the Welshman making yardage almost every time he had the ball. From one of these bursts, Oaks found themselves camped on the Camberley line and the games defining period got underway. As the Oaks forwards looked to squeeze over the line, they were continually thwarted by the excellent home defence, cheered on by their vocal support. At one point, flanker McRae seemed to have got over, but to his disappointment, the referee deemed the ball had been held up and moved back to give Oaks a penalty for a home side infringement. Phases later, due to outstanding pressure from Camberley, Oaks made a handling error which allowed the home side to relieve the pressure. It was clear that both sets of players had given everything and those watching applauded the commitment from desire from all thirty on the field.

The defensive display clearly gave the home side a boost and they were to go further ahead after making their way

down to Oaks 22. Indeed they may have had more had handling errors and resolute Oaks defence not played a part, but a well taken penalty from Smart gave them an all-important 11 point lead with under 10 minutes to go. To their credit, Oaks came straight back and Ben Adams stroked over a penalty from in front to bring them back within the crucial seven points.

And that score was to remain, with the home side taking the victory to the delight of the home support. An excellent game of high level, high pressure rugby and a real treat for those that were there to spectate.

"First and foremost, congratulations to Camberley on the win. They deserved it and we have no qualms about that" said Head Coach Adam Bowman after the match. "Both sets of players gave everything and I think all the supporters would agree with me that it was an excellent match of the rugby."

He added: "We have come through a hard block of fixtures just now and the boys have done exceptionally well. Of course we wanted the win and the players are really disappointed not to, but to come away with a bonus point is also pleasing. It was a tough old game and perhaps the exertions of the last few weeks caught up with us a bit. We are going to rest up and get ourselves right for the final run-in now, which is going to be incredibly tough but very exciting. It starts with Havant in two weeks' time and we would like as many supporters down at the Paddock as possible to get behind the boys to give them that final push."
