## Ide Hill close in on title after fine away win

**Kent County League Division One West:  
Long Lane 0 Ide Hill 2**

Ide Hill climbed to the summit of the league on Saturday afternoon with a gritty win over Long Lane in blustery conditions.

The visitors knew, with Sydenham and Chipstead not playing, that a win would take them a point clear in the race for the title, but the victory was far from straightforward against a side trying to rebuild following a huge exodus of players mid-season.

With a near full strength squad, Ide Hill started with real intent and swarmed the anxious hosts, carving chance after chance in a frenetic opening 15 minutes when Ide Hill threatened to run riot.

The first came after five minutes and relentless pressure, the impressive Sam Heasman wriggling in the box and drawing the penalty from the stretched defender. Craig Jackson stepped up and slid his 14th of the season in for what seemed would be the first of many.

Playing with the swirling wind at their backs, Ide Hill continued to dominate against a callow Long Lane side; Matt Bunn racing clear shortly after only to see his one on one well saved by the legs of the goalkeeper. Columb Grant was operating with his usual class and also came close in the opening period, with nice interplay resulting in him firing goalward and drawing a good save.

Ide Hill deservedly doubled the lead after 10 minutes, Ben Holder throwing in to the box and Jackson stabbing a close range finish in to the far right corner. Bunn saw another good chance saved after 20 minutes before the Ide Hill blitz subsided and Long Lane began to get a foothold in the game. The game

thereafter seemed to succumb to the conditions, becoming more even with the home side threatening to get back into the game and looking forward to their own wind assisted half to come.

Man of the Match Mike McKay was to thank for a precious clean sheet, pulling off an outstanding save after 40 minutes from a swirling piledriver which meant Ide Hill went in to the break two goals clear having played well for a portion of the half.

The second half, in to the wind, was predictably a grind for Ide Hill, defending stoically with George Kensell, Phil Alteirac, Ben Pearson and McKay holding firm in the face of patches of intense pressure. A series of corners and set pieces caused havoc in the visitors' box, needing goal line clearances and last ditch tackles in an increasingly fraught last half an hour.

Ide Hill still had chances to pull further clear in the final 15 minutes though; substitute Shaun Boyle using his nimble footwork to carve out a chance which he fired wide, then missing a close range header with 10 to play. Jack Edmeads also fired one wide with his left when he perhaps expected to score.

But Ide Hill saw out the remainder of the game in a gutsy if not brilliant performance to reclaim top spot with 3 games to play. Manager Paul McDonagh was pleased with the result "The conditions were tough again, a strong wind and a tight pitch weren't the best for flowing football. But on the whole we had enough good chances to score loads more." And on MOTM McKay "He made a couple of key saves at crucial times and had to sweep and kick so much with the wind, we needed him today and he delivered."

# Suns maintain 100% league record despite temporary scare from London Lions

**WBBL Championship: Sevenoaks Suns 56 BA London Lions 51**

Sevenoaks Suns temporarily returned to the top of the WBBL Championship table after overcoming a strong BA London Lions, at home on Sunday afternoon.

It maintains their perfect league record, moving to 14-0, whilst Leicester Riders occupy top spot having played three games more. The visitors led by five early in the contest, but Sevenoaks moved ahead and never looked back, although it was never comfortable. The gap peaked at 10 points with the Lions staying competitive and kept up the pressure to the final buzzer.

Sevenoaks gave up 18 turnovers in the contest, though they were not punished as their defence kept their opponents to under 30% shooting from the floor.

Clark led the way for the Suns with a game-high 18 points along with seven rebounds and three assists with two



other team-mates in double figures in the win. Leading scorers for Sevenoaks were Clark (18), Judit Fritz (10) and Jess Good (10). Suns Head Coach Len Busch was unimpressed with the win stating

that his players hadn't turned up for the match. "We will go through the video and see what went wrong as the players struggled to get maximum points on the board today" he said.

## Oaks start to think about life after National Premier

**England Hockey Mens Premier: Brooklands MU 6 Sevenoaks 4**

Sevenoaks were officially relegated from the National Premier Division on Sunday after a bizarre 6-4 defeat away to Brooklands MU.

As has often been the case this season, Sevenoaks started well and we're enjoying some good territory but Brooklands with practically their first attack opened the scoring when the Oaks defence allowed the Brooklands forward too much space in the D and he fired a reverse stick strike into the back of the net to make it 1-0. Almost immediately Oaks gifted Brooklands a second when a harmless ball into the D was given straight back to the attacker who scored from a narrow angle to make it 2-0.

The Oaks response was superb and they pulled a goal back when Tim Warrington latched onto a George Lilley pass and rounded two defenders before unleashing a powerful shot on goal that went between the keeper's legs to make it 2-1. Oaks had the better of the

remainder of the half, with Craig Morton having a lofted shot cleared off the line. Oaks also had five penalty corners to draw level but failed to score any of them and entered half time 2-1 down.

Oaks again started the second half well but conceded with Brooklands first foray forwards. A sideline hit was taken quickly and the forward managed to run all the way into the D unchallenged before sliding a reverse shot under Potton to make it 3-1. Brooklands then added a controversial 4th and 5th. First a penalty stroke was awarded and converted after the Brooklands forward did an air shot in the build up to the award of the penalty, and second when the Oaks defender was shoved off the ball in the D before the forward converted a reverse stick shot. At 5-1 down Oaks rallied and Duncan Parnis pulled a goal back with a powerfully struck reverse stick strike into the corner of the net to make it 5-2. The hope was short-lived though as a turnover in midfield saw Brooklands score on the counter attack to make it 6-2. To their

credit Oaks continued to fight and Tim Warrington added his second goal of the game after a slick move involving Morton, Parnis and Ed Matts ended with Warrington firing through the keeper's legs on his reverse to make it 6-3. Shortly after Oaks were back within two goals when Andrew Ross lifted the ball over the advancing keeper and Andrew Oxburgh volleyed the loose ball home for 6-4. Oaks had another three or four penalty corners in the second half which, in addition to the five in the first half could have seen them easily win the game, but profligacy in their set pieces cost them dearly, as it has done all season, and the full time score ended 6-4 to Brooklands.

The result means Sevenoaks can no longer catch Exeter ahead of them in the relegation playoff spot, and they will be automatically relegated into Division One South next season. They still have two games remaining against 1st place Surbiton and 3rd place Beeston to enjoy the end of their stay at the top table of English Hockey.



# Swimming Club shines at National Finals

Sevenoaks Swimming Club's 'A' team recently returned from the National Arena 'B' final in Cardiff securing a fantastic 6th place overall, and 4th place in the combined relays. The qualifying process took place over the latter part of 2018 and involved over 350 clubs and 10,000 swimmers (in six regional leagues) battling their way through the three qualifying rounds to reach the prestigious finals.

Only the top 20 clubs made it through, the first 10 to the 'A' finals and the next ten to the 'B' final. On the day, Sevenoaks fielded one of the youngest squads, with only one male and two female swimmers competing in the Open events, with the remaining Open category spots being fielded by their younger swimmers. Their opposition consisted of the eventual winners Mount Kelly as well as Winchester, Southport, Camden Swiss Cottage, Thanet, Cambridge, Milton Keynes, Bromley and Ipswich.

Each member of the Sevenoaks team gave every ounce of effort, many swimming in back to back events. There were plenty of top three finishes in both the individual and relay events. Most notable of these were the individual 1st place finishes from Kara Dimond (14/U 100m breaststroke) Eva Okaro (100m freestyle and 100m butterfly) and Aiden



McMillan (16/U butterfly) together with the Girls 14U 4 x 50m freestyle team - Eva Okaro, Samriddhi Das, Imogen Stoddart and Isabella Okaro who also took the win. Eva was justly rewarded for her efforts, winning the award for the top swimmer in the 14/under age group (even more remarkable because she isn't yet 13!) presented by Commonwealth Gold medallist Alys Thomas.

Head Coach Keiron Piper said: "I am incredibly proud of each and every swimmer – reaching the finals with such a young team was a huge achievement, and to come 6th against huge opposition was justly deserved".
